


Transportation Methods

Travelling Between Hongkong And Shenzhen

With the two regions being close together, many people move daily between the two. There are multiple ways of traveling between Hong Kong to Shenzhen which include the train, ferry, and bus.



Visa

You'll need a visa. Many people will apply for the visa in their home country prior to travel such as via <u>CVASC</u> if you are in Australia. Visa laws are relatively fluid and changing often, and also vary based on nationality. There are several options for getting a China Visa in Hong Kong before heading over to Shenzhen. Many travel agents will assist with getting a visa, such as <u>CTS</u>, or you can apply to direct to the <u>China Foreign Ministry in Hong Kong</u>, and some visas are issued at the border. There is a short-term 'Shenzhen Visa' which allows you to visit Shenzhen for 5 days, which is available at the border, to some nationalities.

Ways of Travelling

Way 1: Private Car

Door to door service in luxury people movers. It's a shared ride in a seven-seat van, it's usually comfortable and quick but that may depend on traffic. Service available from 07:00 – 24:00 every day.

Way 2: Ferry

By taking ferry from Shenzhen to Hongkong Airport, passengers can enjoy tag through luggage service and departure tax refund service.

Shenzhen Shekou Ferry Port

From Shenzhen Shekou Port, passengers can take direct ferry to Hong Kong (Tuen Mun Ferry Terminal, SkyPier of Hong Kong International Airport and Hong Kong Macau Ferry Terminal).

Shenzhen Fuyong Port of Baoan Airport

For passengers going to take flight at Hong Kong Airport, you can take the direct boat from Shenzhen Airport Fuyong Port.

At Shenzhen Airport, passengers can take free shuttle buses from the terminal building to the port. The bus could be found at Gate 3, Arrival Hall, Terminal A and Gate 6, Arrival Hall, Terminal B.

Way 3: Metro/Train

there are two ways to connect to Shenzhen Metro from Hong Kong's MTR.

- 1. HK MTR to Lo Wu Station connects to Shenzhen Metro Line 1 Luo Hu Station
- 2. HK MTR to Lok Ma Chau Station connects to Shenzhen Metro Line 4
 Futian Check Point Station



To get to Shenzhen via anywhere on the MTR line in Hong Kong, take the Kwun Tong (green) MTR line to Kowloon Tong and do a short 5 min walk to the East Rail (light blue) line which brings you north to the HK/China mainland border.

Another option is to transfer at Hung Hom Station, which is the first/last top on the East Rail line; or at Tai Wai if coming from the Ma On Shan line.

Way 4: Cross-border Buses

For the privately operated shuttle buses, which are comfortable A/C 40 seater buses, operated by numerous companies inc. Trans Island and CTS, you buy the ticket BEFORE you enter the border building on the Shenzhen side. The ticket booth is right at the entry gate, you cannot miss it. The bus timetable and destinations in HK which include Causeway Bay, HK Macau Ferry Terminal, Tseun Wan, Mong Kok, Teun Mun, Ocean Park, Disneyland, and Tung Chung via Trans Island. Once you have the ticket, then proceed through China Customs, then HK Customs and once you walk out the building head right with your ticket in hand.


On the Hong Kong side heading to Shenzhen, there are numerous pickup points for the cross-border buses ran by <u>CTS Travel</u>, <u>Trans-Island</u>, and <u>Eternal East</u>.

Where is Attom Technology

The address of Attom Technology is <u>04# Yangchong Road, Baoan District</u> <u>Shenzhen</u>. Its about 30 minutes drive from Shenzhen Airport to Attom Technology.

These crossing ports are close: Fuyong Ferry Port, Shenzhen Airport, Shekou Ferry Port, Shenzhen Bay Port.


Hotels

- 3. Hung Hom, 6:30 am to 11:45 pm
- 4. Lok Ma Chau, 24 hours
- 5. Lok Ma Chau Spur Line, 6:30 am to 10:30 pm
- 6. Man Kam To, 7:00 am to 10:00 pm
- 7. Sha Tau Kok, 7:00 am to 10:00 pm
- 8. China Ferry Terminal, 6:00 am to midnight
- 9. Macau Ferry Terminal, 24 hours
- 10. Tuen Mun Ferry Terminal, 7:00 am to 10:00 pm
- 11. Shenzhen Bay, 6:30 am to midnight
